



 - Grant applications




Where in your work is research useful?






Concept Mapping: What is it?


Tool:

- Explore Controlled vocabulary and natural language
- Expand identify area other areas to explore
- Plan Be efficient and effective!





Need to be fluid / flexible . Cannot be generalized. Very dangerous

Breast Milk	Milk, Human [MESH]


Cancer **OR** Neoplasms

Concept Mapping: How does it work?







